

- 6th generation family farmer
- Grow non-GMO food-grade soybeans, corn, wheat and seed wheat
- Crop ratio: 45% soybean, 45% corn, 10% wheat



Growing IP Soybeans

- Grown for Bluegrass Farms in Ohio for tofu, miso and soy milk
- Premium received for non-GMO soybeans
- Ohio well recognized for high-quality, food-grade soy

Non-GMO Farming

- Fall: spraying program and dry fertilizer
- Spring: burndown herbicides, mid-April planting, post-spray application for weeds
- Summer: fungicide application on R3 or R4 stage soybeans
- Fall: harvest begins





2021 Growing Season

- Timely planting
- Adequate rainfall
- Timely harvest with average yields
