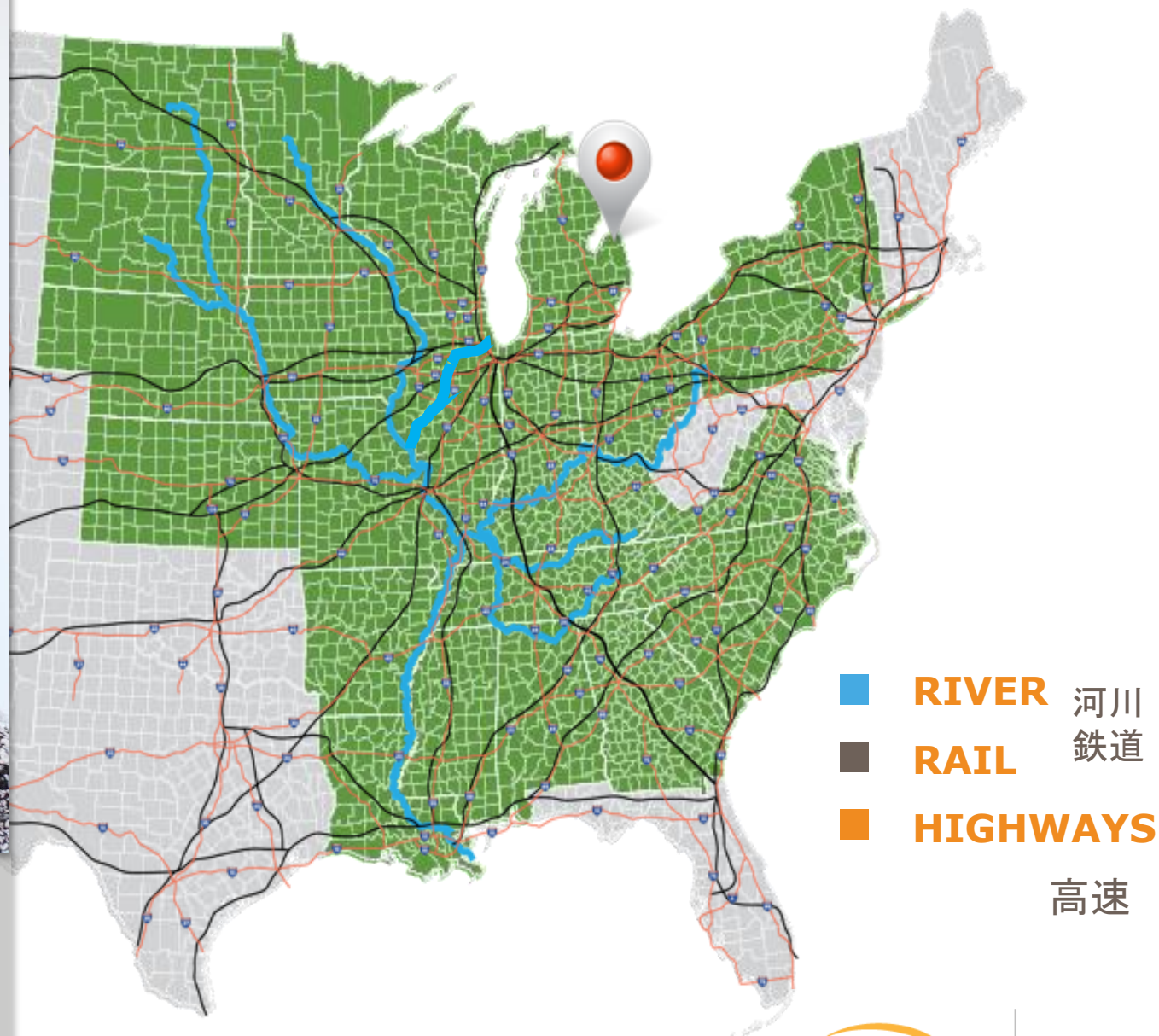

2024 Crop Report

Planting

- Little winter moisture
- Wetter spring
- Completed by May

Growing season

- Started wet, turned hot & dry
- Scouting & monitoring
- Timely late rains

Harvest

- Finished by October
- Destinations: on-farm storage and local elevators
- Yields on par with five-year average



2025 Crop Outlook

Timing

- Soybeans typically planted in May

Planting

- In Michigan, planting typically from early May to late June

Weather

- Warmer and wetter than normal

Soybeans

- We plant soybeans after corn
- U.S. intends to plant slightly more hectares than last year

Growing Season

- Monitoring, scouting
